

## Revised Beach Rules 2020

- Membership badges must be shown upon entering the beach.
- Daily Occupancy will be limited.
- The lifeguards and the beach manager will be required to follow all current Sussex County Department of Health requirements and guidelines for compliance with respect to COVID-19.
- Social distancing at all beaches is required, staying six feet apart, excluding immediate family members, caretakers, household members, or romantic partners.
- Protective masks are required where other social distancing measures are difficult to maintain.
- The beachfront will be marked by cones every six feet to demonstrate appropriate spacing for social distancing. Therefore, beach capacity is limited.
- The bathrooms at the beach will only be open when a lifeguard or beach manager is on duty to regulate traffic flow and maintain proper sanitization.
- Bathroom use will be limited to 1 member/family unit at a time.
- The snack stand will remain closed until further notice.
- Due to enforcing social distancing guidelines, swim lessons cannot be offered this season.
- All organized social gatherings including festivals, movies, fireworks, picnics, contact activities and sports will be prohibited until further notice.
