This year, we have two lifeguards (Emily and Mackenzie), along with our recreation director (Brianna) who have trained to obtain WSI certification so that we can once again offer swim lessons to children in our community! We currently have over 30 families registered for lessons this season! These lessons are **free** of cost for community members who are in good standing. SENIOR CITIZEN DUES DISCOUNT:

Members who are 62 years of age or older are eligible for a 10% discount on the dues. You must provide the office with proof of age to receive the discount. (license or birth certificate). This discount shall not be applied if the account is currently receiving a 10% Veteran's Discount.

VETERAN/ACTIVE SOLDIER DISCOUNT

Members in good standing that are Veterans or active soldiers shall be afforded a ten (10%) percent discount on their yearly dues. Proof of service must be provided. This discount shall not be applied if the account is currently receiving a 10% Senior Citizen Discount.

DUES PAYMENT: The last Dues payment for 2023 is due on August 15th. This payment will receive a late fee if it is not received in the office or postmarked by September 1st.
